

Method 1: Disable Proxy via Internet Properties

- 1) Open Control Panel (via Windows Search) > Network and Sharing Center > Internet Options.
- 2) Go to the Connections tab and click LAN Settings.
- 3) Uncheck "Use automatic configuration script"
- 4) Uncheck "Use a proxy server for your LAN" and click OK.

Method 2: Disable Proxy via Windows Settings

Windows 10 / Windows 11

- 1) Open Settings: Press **Win + I** to open the Windows Settings menu.
- 2) Go to Proxy Settings: Click "Network & Internet", then select "Proxy".
- 3) Disable Proxy:
 - a) Use setup script ☐ Turn off
 - b) Manual proxy setup ☐ Turn off "Use a proxy server"
- 4) Restart your computer if needed.

Method 3: Modify Registry Settings (Advanced Users)

- 1) Press **Win + R**, type regedit, and press Enter.
- 2) Navigate to:
HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Software\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Internet Settings
- 3) Find AutoConfigURL and delete it.
- 4) Find ProxyEnable and set its value to 0.
- 5) Restart your computer if needed.

Tip: If one method doesn't work, try another. Some settings may be enforced by your network administrator or security software.
